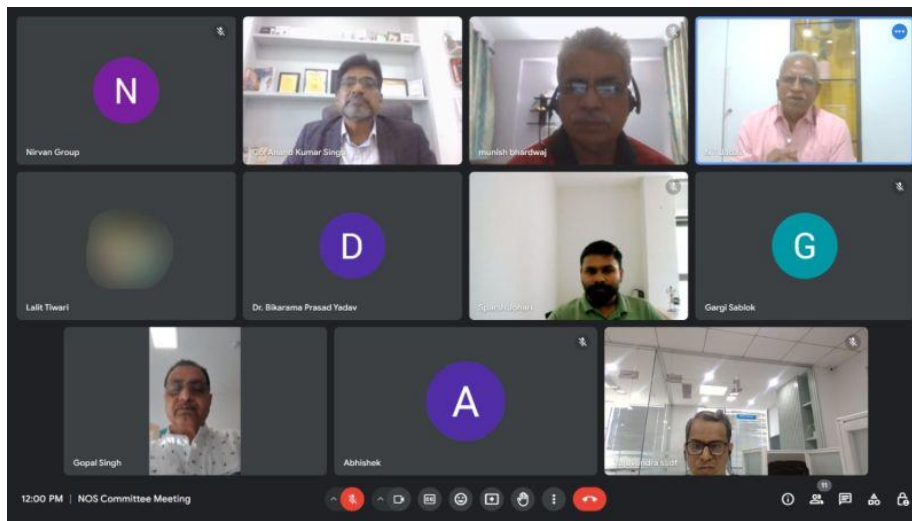


SSDF Holds 4th NOS Committee Meeting to Shape Future Skill Development Initiatives
