About the Micro-Credential Program:

The Micro credential provides the safety protocols, process required to be followed and personal protective equipment (PPEs) to be used by the workers at construction site while performing various construction activities at height, at elevated platforms, depths, handling materials and precautions to be taken while moving at the construction site and maintaining a tidy work-site environment.

Key Learning Outcomes:

1. Identify common hazards at construction sites (e.g., falls, electrical hazards, struck-by, caught-in).
2. Understand the proper use of PPE tailored to construction activities.
3. Follow safe work procedures for high-risk tasks such as working at height, excavation, lifting, and hot work.
4. Adhere to site safety signage, barricading, and emergency response protocols.
5. Report unsafe conditions, near-misses, and incidents according to site protocols.
