

SSDF VISITS BIFS HALDWANI FOR FIRE SAFETY OFFICER ACCREDITATION AND MICROCREDENTIAL ROLLOUT



As part of its strategic commitment to building a robust, quality-driven safety skilling ecosystem, the **Safety Skills Development Foundation (SSDF)** recently conducted an **on-site visit to the BIFS Skill Training Centre, Haldwani (Uttarakhand)**.

The purpose of the visit was to assess the centre's compliance and readiness for delivering the **Fire Safety Officer training programme**, including the newly introduced **Micro credential on Fire Safety** curated by SSDF.

During the visit, SSDF experts reviewed:

- Physical infrastructure and fire drill facilities
- Practical training setups for extinguishers, alarms, and evacuation drills
- Trainer qualification and delivery capability
- Records and documentation protocols
- Simulation resources for fire response planning

The **SSDF Fire Safety Micro credential** is designed as a 15-hour short-duration course emphasizing:

- Fire hazard identification.
- Equipment familiarization and handling
- Legal and site compliance
- Digital fire safety documentation
- Practical fire emergency simulations

SSDF appreciated the initiative-taking engagement of the BIFS team and encouraged further strengthening of firsthand delivery, assessment readiness, and community outreach in fire safety awareness.

This visit reinforces SSDF's larger mission of accrediting and enabling **future-ready safety training centres** aligned with **occupational health, safety, and environmental excellence**.
