Training Overview & Highlights:

Day 1: Foundational Learning

- Roles and responsibilities of a Fire Safety Officer
- Basics of fire science, fire triangle and tetrahedron
- Statutory provisions and fire safety regulations

Day 2: Systems & Equipment

- Types and functioning of fire detection, alarm, and suppression systems.
- Inspection of fire protection equipment
- Principles of fire risk assessment and audit planning

Day 3: Emergency Planning

- Designing and implementing evacuation procedures
- Fire Command structure and responsibilities of Emergency Response Teams
- Coordination with external fire and rescue services

Day 4: Industry-Specific Applications

- Fire safety risks in sectors such as chemical, warehousing, and electrical.
- Fire load analysis and smoke control systems.
- Review of real case studies and lessons learned.

Day 5: Practical Evaluation & Mock Drills

- Demonstration and use of fire extinguishers
- Full-scale evacuation mock drill
- Final evaluation and participant feedback

Key Outcomes:

By the end of the program, all participants demonstrated:

- Proficiency in identifying workplace fire hazards.
- Competence in using firefighting equipment and leading emergency procedures.
- Awareness of national fire codes and best practices
- Capability to contribute meaningfully to their organization's fire safety system.
