The program brings together **Shift Supervisors**, **Maintenance Teams**, **EHS professionals**, and **HR representatives**, with the aim of strengthening workplace safety culture, ensuring compliance with global standards, and enhancing hazard management capabilities in the textile sector.

Key Highlights from the beginning of the program:

- Global Textile Industry Overview: Industry trends in sustainability, automation, smart textiles & circular economy.

- Manufacturing Process & Job Roles: Complete textile process flow and department-specific safety responsibilities.

- Process & Job Safety Standards: SOPs across spinning, weaving, dyeing, finishing, warehousing, with emphasis on machine guarding, lockout–tagout, and PPE standards.
- Hazard & Risk Management: Identification of mechanical, chemical, ergonomic, fire hazards, risk audits, incident learnings, and safety innovations.
- This collaboration marks a major step in aligning industry best practices with skill development and capacity building, empowering participants to drive safer, smarter, and more sustainable textile operations.
