

SSDF CONDUCTS TILE LAYING SKILL UPGRADATION TRAINING IN TAMIL NADU

Safety Skill Development Foundation (SSDF) is implementing a 7-day Tile Laying Skill Upgradation Program in Tamil Nadu to strengthen practical competencies of construction workers engaged in floor and wall finishing works.

Conducted in partnership with Larsen & Toubro, the program forms part of an ongoing initiative to skill and upskill more than 5,000 workers across multiple sectors

Program Coverage

The training program covers both theoretical understanding and hands-on practice, including:

- Safety procedures, PPE usage, and safe handling of hand and power tools
- Measurement, marking, and cutting techniques for tiles and stones
- Surface preparation for floor and wall tile installation
- Fixing of floor and wall tiles with proper line, level, and alignment
- Application of tile adhesives and standard fixing procedures
- Grouting techniques using cement-based and epoxy grouts, including curing and cleaning
- Marble laying, edge finishing, polishing, and final surface inspection
- Quality control checks to ensure durability, aesthetics, and compliance with site standards

Expected Outcomes

Upon completion of the program, participants are expected to:

- Demonstrate improved precision and workmanship in tile and marble laying
- Follow standardized safety practices and reduce on-site risks
- Execute tile fixing with correct alignment, spacing, and finishing quality
- Apply appropriate adhesives and grouts as per surface requirements
- Minimize material wastage and rework through correct methods
- Enhance employability across residential, commercial, and infrastructure projects

Through this initiative, SSDF continues to strengthen construction finishing trades by promoting skill standardization, safety awareness, and quality-driven execution, aligned with national skilling and labour welfare objectives.
